

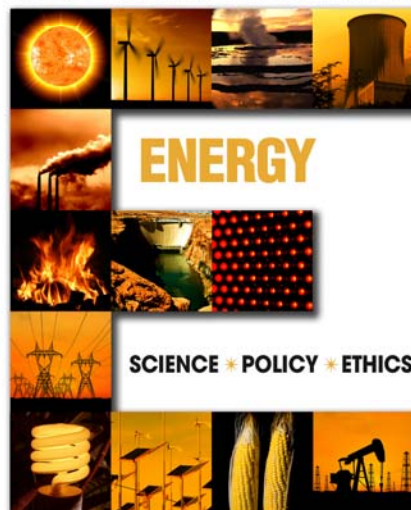
# CALL FOR STUDENT PRESENTATIONS
